

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

PORCELAIN VENEERS FROM A-Z

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Speaker: Effrat Habsha, BSc, DDS, Dip. Prostho, MSc, FRCD(C)

The focus of this hands-on program is to provide the general practitioner with key insights in achieving predictable, esthetic outcomes with porcelain veneers. COMPREHENSIVE SOCKET PRESERVATION AND LATERAL RIDGE BONE AUGMENTATION FOR FUTURE IMPLANT PLACEMENT

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Speaker: Paul Jang, DMD, FCDS(BC), FRCD(C)

Planning and preparing a site for future implant placement is an important step in achieving success in implant dentistry. Having adequate bone volume and density is critical to the success of surgical implant placement. In this course, participating doctors will learn techniques involved in extraction socket preservation and guide bone regeneration. An overview of all available techniques will be discussed during the lecture portion followed by observation of live surgery performed by course director and periodontist, Dr. Paul Jang.




